GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PERFORMERS AND ARTISTS:

- Because parking is limited, please park in the northeast portion of the shopping center near Famous Footwear.
- Visual Artists** – Check in at the Arts Council Meniffee booth in front of Daniel's Jewelry between 8:30 and 10:00 a.m. to get your space number. You must be set up by 10:30 a.m. Artists may unload near their space after check-in, but must park by Famous Footwear.
- Performers** – Check in at the Arts Council Meniffee booth in front of Daniel's Jewelry at least 30 minutes prior to your performance time. Performers must provide accompaniment to the DJ prior to performance.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- There is a \$50 fee per artist booth for non-ACM Artists. No fee for ACM Artists and Performers. To become an artist, the cost is \$50 which makes you eligible to participate in ACM events during the next 12-month period. Make checks payable to: Arts Council Meniffee and include it with this application. Mail to: Arts Council Meniffee, PO Box 385, Meniffee CA 92586 by April 19, 2025.

ARTIST SPACE INFORMATION:

- Spaces are approximately 100 square feet and square or rectangle in shape. The limited number of spaces are assigned in the order that applications are received - "first-come, first-served" basis. Some spaces may have unmovable tables. Plan on using a black table cloth provided.
- Take-down is after 4 pm. Everyone is expected to maintain their booths from 11:00 am to 4 pm. No early break-down, please, without approval from an Arts Council Meniffee board member.
- Artists must provide their own E-Z Up, chairs, additional tables and display units for their spaces.

PERFORMER INFORMATION:

- Sound system is provided. Bring your own recordings for accompaniment. You may bring your equipment at your own risk.
- Performers may provide business cards to the public during performance but must purchase a booth to sell CDs, DVDs or other merchandise.

WAIVER of LIABILITY and HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration of receiving permission to utilize the Common Areas at Countryside Marketplace shopping center, Menifee, California, as has been designated by prior agreement with Arts Council of Menifee and Retail Marketing Group/Rose Marinello, (hereinafter referred to as the "Premises") for which the 13th Annual Arts Council exhibition and public fair will be held in April 2025, I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue Shin Yen Retail Property Management, Newport Property LLC, and all of Their officers, assigns, employees, contractors, agents (hereinafter referred to as "Releasees") from any and all liability, claim, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) that may be sustained by me, or to any property belonging to me, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, while participating in such athletic, sales, leisure, patronage, vendor, exhibitor, purveyor of goods/services, etc. (hereinafter referred to as "Event") while in, on, or upon the above Premises where the event is scheduled to occur.

I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any risk of loss, property damage, or personal injury, including death, that may be sustained by me, or any loss or damage to property owned by me, as a result of being engaged at these Premises for this Event, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise. I further hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, including court costs and attorney's fees, that may be incurred due to my participation in said Event, and any subsequent incident or cause of action against any Releasee.

It is my express intent that this Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement shall bind the members of my family and spouse if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns, and personal representative, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a release, waiver, discharge and covenant not to sue the above-named Releasees, I hereby further agree that this Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California. In signing this release, I acknowledge and represent that I have read and understand it and sign it voluntarily; that I am at least eighteen years of age and fully competent; I execute this Release for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.
